

Execution degrades under leadership threat, Even in high talent organisations

When Leaders feel threatened, execution degrades, regardless of talent, tools or intent

The Warning Signs

- Decisions slow down, approvals move upward
- Priorities multiply, focus fragments
- Truth arrives late, or dressed up
- Meetings increase, outcomes decrease
- Accountability becomes theatre
- “Alignment” becomes forced agreement
- High performers disengage quietly

The Unspoken Cause

When leaders perceive threat, self-protection takes over. Control tightens, communication filters, and strategic focus is lost.

The issue isn't culture - it's the impact of perceived threat on leadership behaviour.

The Cost of Inaction

- Strategy execution, drift and rework
- Retention loss in critical roles, especially mid-senior teams
- Transformation spend that produces compliance, not capability
